



Number of Ski Areas Operating Per State During 2018/19 Season

LAKEWOOD, Colo.— August 1, 2019 – Of the 37 states with operating ski areas, New York leads with 51 areas in operation during the 2018/19 season, followed by Michigan’s 43 and Wisconsin and Colorado with 31. There were a total of 476 operating ski areas during the 2018/19 season. Here’s a breakout by state:
