***Number of Ski Areas Operating Per State During 2010/11 Season***

LAKEWOOD, Colo.– September 1, 2011 – Of the 37 states with operating ski areas, New York leads with 52 areas in operation during the 2010/11 season, followed by Michigan’s 43, Wisconsin’s 32 and Pennsylvania with 30. There were a total of 486 operating ski areas during the 2010/11 season. Here’s a breakout by state:
