The *NSAA Journal* is calling all resorts to give us their best shots! In commemorating the 10th Anniversary of National Safety Awareness Week, the *Journal* is holding the first-ever Safety Week Photo Contest, encouraging NSAA member resorts to submit their best photo images from this season's Safety Week festivities. **The winning image will be featured on the cover of the April issue of the *NSAA Journal*.** For resorts, this is an opportunity to gain national recognition for your on-going safety education efforts. For photographers, this is a chance to have your work published on the cover of the leading national trade magazine serving the ski industry. Photos not selected as the winning cover image will still be published in the April issue as part of an article reviewing Safety Week activities at resorts nationwide.

To be considered, images must convey a safety message, or depict resort guests and/or employees engaging in Safety Week activities. Image composition, clarity and those shot in vertical format will be given top consideration. Further guidelines for entering are as follows:

- Entrants must be the owner of the photograph, or otherwise have the rights to submit the photograph for publication;
- By submitting an entry and participating in the contest, entrants assign all rights to publish the photograph to the *NSAA Journal* without limitation and without additional compensation, and releases the *NSAA Journal* from any liability with respect thereto;
- Images must be high-resolution (at least 3600 pixels from top to bottom);
- All entries must be received by February 16, 2009.
